- A new kit is \$35,000 for the airframe and finishing kits included here. Not included are avionics, engine, and cowl. Cowl kits are available for many popular engines. Workmanship is excellent and inspected by EAA292 tech councilors.
- You get free build rental space in the south hangar of the EAA 292 clubhouse.
- EAA292 delivers to you a ready-to-fly airplane.



### Your commitment

- You manage the build. The teens meet every Saturday from 9:00 – 3:00. Typically, there is one mentor for every two teens (or better). Mentors can cover for you, but the overall project direction is managed by you.
- You pay EAA 292 \$30,000 and get to spec everything that goes into the airplane. For \$60,000 - \$70,000 you get a \$90,000 airplane outfitted the way you want it.
